Family Camp Opportunity ~ The members of Peace Lutheran are sponsoring a camp at Trinity Lutheran Camp in Big Fork, Montana from August 9 – 12, 2018. Camp starts at 12 noon on Thursday and ends after worship service on Sunday morning at 12 noon. This is a family camp for all ages. The accommodations are cabin style or there are also RV parking spots in the meadow. Cabins are bunk bed style and you need to bring your own bedding and personal items. There are community shower houses and a dining hall for meals. Meals will be provided, but families are asked to help with food preparation, set-up and clean-up for at least one meal while they are there. There will be morning and evening devotions and Bible study Friday and Saturday mornings. The cost for those who wish to come and enjoy the facilities is \$140 per person. 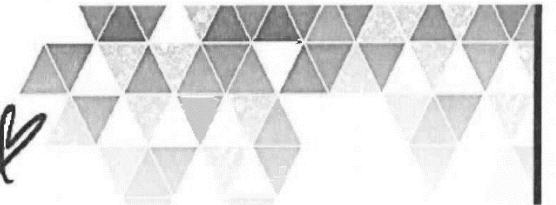
